SPONSORS

Since early Christian times, Candidate for Confirmation have been accompanied by a sponsor when they ask to be admitted as catechumen. The sponsor can be a man or woman. It must be someone who knows the candidate and is willing to help them, and can witness to their morals, faith, and intention. The Sponsor has a unique role in the process leading towards the reception of the sacrament. The sponsor is teacher, spiritual guide, and confidant for the candidate. The sponsor should therefore be someone whose life a powerful witness to the Gospel for it is the sponsor's responsibility to show the catechumen in a friendly way the place the Gospel has in their own life and in society. They also are there to help them in times of doubts and anxieties, to give public testimony for them and to watch over the progress of their Confirmation preparation.

The sponsor should be prepared to attend several of the faith theme sessions with the candidate. This will enable the sponsor to be aware of what the student is learning. It will also help the sponsor in acting as a guide and teacher for the candidate. Following the celebration of Confirmation, the sponsor should continue to be a friend, witness, and guide to the newly confirmed.

The Following guidelines should be used in choosing a sponsor.

Requirements for Sponsor:

1. They must be practicing Catholic, in accord with the Bishops and the Magisterium, who has received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist)
2. They should be someone whose life is an example of living the Good News of the Gospel.
3. They may be the baptismal godparents, or relative but the candidate's parents may not be sponsor (Code of Canon Law no. 874.5). If you have chosen one of your parents, please choose again.
4. They may be either male or female.
5. They should be living within a responsible driving distance of the candidate.
6. They should be in constant touch, in person, or phone with the candidate.

Involvement:

1. They should accept the invitation to help the candidate prepare for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation by being a friend, witness and guide.
2. They should participate in special workshops and liturgies for the sponsors.
3. They should encourage and assist the candidate in the various aspects of the catechesis including the service projects through a close relationship, questioning and counseling.
4. The sponsor should continue to be a friend, witness, and guide to the newly confirmed throughout the rest of their lives.
